Who is Eligible to Participate?

The Winter Musical is open to all students in grades 6-8. Positions are available in both the Cast and on the Tech Crew. (More details about Tech Crew applications will be announced in November... Only about 10 students will be accepted to the Tech Crew.)

Audition Information:

<u>Audition Practice Session</u>: (not required, but HIGHLY recommended!)

Wednesday, October 12, 2022 from 3:00-4:30 PM in the Middle School Auditorium.

We will teach the audition song and dance that will be required during auditions, as well as give time for students to practice the acting portion. Audition sign-up sheets will also be posted.

First Round: You may sign up to audition in groups of two (but a "partner" is not required). When you are called into the audition room, each person will sing INDIVIDUALLY, then read the scene with a partner or director. Please bring your completed **Audition Information Form** to give to the committee. At the end of every 8 auditions, we will call everyone who has auditioned in that group back into the audition room and you will perform the dance audition in a group. Once your group has done <u>all 3 parts</u>, you may leave.

<u>Sign-up sheets</u> will be posted on the Chorus Room¹ (A100) wall on Oct. 11th. Plan to arrive 10 minutes before your scheduled audition if you go home and come back. You are only required to stay for the hour that you sign up, and may leave after you have completed all three parts: sung, read, and danced.

^{*} All cast members are permitted to miss 5 rehearsals and be late to/leave early from 5 rehearsals. Many athletes balance their time within these guidelines so that they can participate in both musical and other activities. You must notify a director ahead of time and you must learn any new material that you miss when not at rehearsal. The only exception to this policy is during the last TWO WEEKS of the show (January 23-February 4). Those practices/run-throughs are mandatory for ALL cast & tech members, NO EXCEPTIONS (except quarantine/illness)! This is especially important for leads at the Saturday Tech Rehearsal and everyone else during the listed Dress Rehearsals, where we use microphones, lights, costumes, etc. for the first time.

^{**}If a cast member is **quarantined**, students are responsible for learning any new material they miss, either by talking to cast mates (on Zoom or after quarantine ends), referencing Google Classroom practice resources, or Zooming a rehearsal if able (expected only for blocking rehearsals and January rehearsals). Please let us know in advance by emailing <u>fanellik@nhsd.net marcellusl@nhsd.net</u> if you are unable to attend and are available for a Zoom meeting.

CINDERELLA'S PRINCE

I have been looking all night... for her. (BAKER'S WIFE appears behind a tree and eavesdrops.) The beautiful one I danced the evening with.

RAPUNZEL'S PRINCE

Where did she go?

CINDERELLA'S PRINCE

Disappeared.

RAPUNZEL'S PRINCE

I, too, have found a lovely maiden. She lives in the top of a tall tower that has no door or stairs.

CINDERELLA'S PRINCE

And how do you manage a visit?

RAPUNZEL'S PRINCE

I stand beneath her tower and say, "Rapunzel, Rapunzel, let down your hair to me." And then she lowers the longest, most beautiful head of hair – yellow as corn—

(BAKER'S WIFE reacts.)

- which I climb to her.

CINDERELLA'S PRINCE

(starts laughing hysterically) Rapunzel! What kind of name is that? You jest!

RAPUNZEL'S PRINCE

(defensive)

She is as true as your maiden. A maiden running from a prince? Does that make sense? None would run from us.


CINDERELLA'S PRINCE

(sober) Yet one has.


(#22 - AGONY begins.)

Acting Audition - OPTION 2

(BAKER'S WIFE grabs a shoe.)

BAKER'S WIFE

And I must have your shoe.

CINDERELLA

Stop that!

(The two engage in a tug-of-war over the shoe, and the dialogue overlaps.)

BAKER'S WIFE

I need it to have a baby!

CINDERELLA

(through clenched teeth)
And I need it to get out of here!

(CINDERELLA wins the battle over the shoe and desperately runs offstage; BAKER'S WIFE is embarrassed by her own behavior. BAKER'S WIFE straightens herself up as CINDERELLA'S PRINCE with STEWARD bound onstage, only to curtsey deeply again.)

CINDERELLA'S PRINCE

Where did she go?

BAKER'S WIFE

Who?

STEWARD

Don't play the fool, woman.

BAKER'S WIFE

Oh! You mean the beautiful young maiden in the ball gown? She went in that direction. I was trying to hold her here for you...

CINDERELLA'S PRINCE

I can capture my own damsel, thank you.

(CINDERELLA'S PRINCE and STEWARD wash offered on

(BAKER runs onstage with MILKY-WHITE. They are both out of breath.)

BAKER'S WIFE

You've the cow!

BAKER

Yes. I've the cow. We've two of the four.

(MILKY-WHITE continues to breathe heavily.)

BAKER'S WIFE

Three.

BAKER

Two!

BAKER'S WIFE

(pulls the hair from her pocket)
Three! Compare this to your corn.

(BAKER does so and smiles.)

BAKER

Where did you find it?

BAKER'S WIFE

(false modesty)
I pulled it from a maiden in a tower.

BAKER

(looking at hair)

Three!

BAKER'S WIFE

And I almost had the fourth, but she got away.

BAKER

We've one entire day left. Surely we can locate the slipper by then.

BAKER'S WIFE

We? You mean you'll allow me to stay?


BAKER

(embarrassed)

Well... perhaps it will take the two of us to get this child.

(#25 - IT TAKES TWO begins.) .

CINDERELLA: Perhaps.

BAKER'S WIFE: Perhaps? Oh, to be pursued by a Prince. All that pursues me is tomorrow's bread.




(We hear the first chime of midnight.)

(The second chime sounds; chimes continue under.)


CINDERELLA: Will you look over there? An enormous vine growing

(CINDERELLA begins to leave.)



(The final chime of midnight is heard.)
